In India, the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) published its first report on the All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) in the year 2010. The objective of the research work is to analyze the growth of higher education institutions and students enrolment in India and U.P. The research work is based on secondary data, collected from the AISHE report published from 2010-2017. Maximum growth of universities and colleges in India is 8.39% and 8.32% and U.P. is 7.46% and 19.24% respectively.
